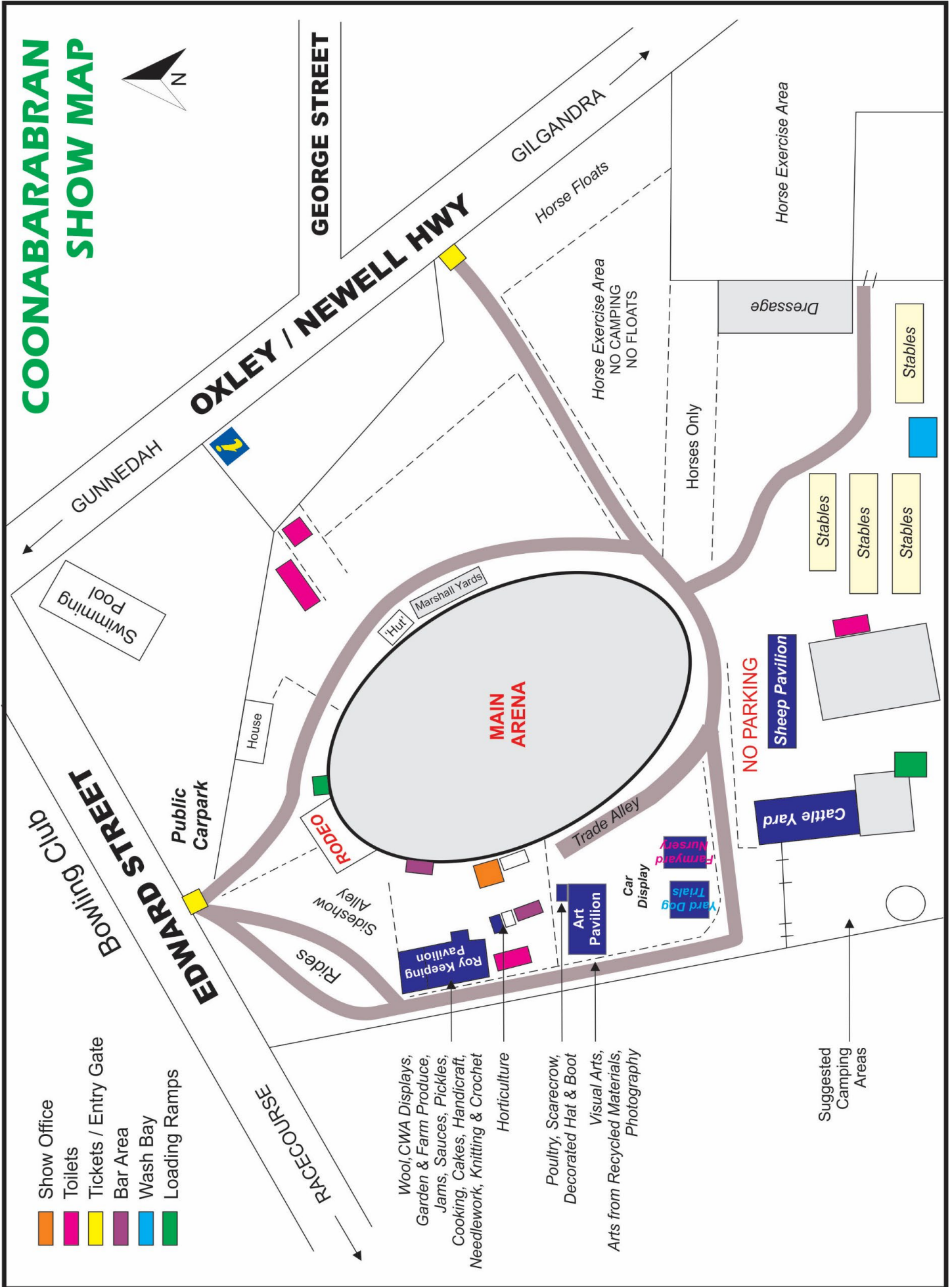

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

1. Horse riders and all stock handlers must sign the indemnity form and wear wrist bands. Exhibitors cannot compete or exhibit without identification.
2. Exhibitors for all other sections must sign the indemnity form.
3. Exhibitors when entering exhibit, must furnish the Secretary with description of exhibits and the number of the class in which they wish to exhibit, upon the proper form together with the entry fee, by the due date shown in relevant section.
4. Exhibitors must obtain an exhibit label from the Secretary, affix to the exhibit [s] and deliver to the stewards of the section at or on the hour provided for in the schedule. This does not apply to exhibits arriving by mail etc., which are to be addressed to the Secretary and forwarded in time to reach him/her, two days prior to the section close date.
5. Exhibits must not be removed from the pavilions before 6. 00pm on the second day of the Show and then only by permission of the Head Steward.
6. Exhibitors of stock must have their exhibits in readiness to parade for judging at the hour notified, or when called upon by the Stewards.
7. The Grand Parade will be held on the afternoon of the second day and all stock able to be led, whether prize winners or not, are asked to participate.
8. Exhibitors of non-competitive articles must supply the Secretary with a list of the articles he or she intends to exhibit.
9. Space will be let on application to the Secretary/Steward and sites may be inspected on the grounds by appointment.
10. Protest must be delivered to the Secretary, in writing within four hours of the judges' decision, accompanied by \$25.00, which will be forfeited to the Association if the Disputes Committee considers the appeal frivolous, and the decision of the Disputes Committee shall be final and without appeal.
11. The Disputes Committee shall consist of three members, being the President or a Vice President, Head Steward of section and another Committee member.
12. Prize money will be payable by the HEAD STEWARDS between 6.00 pm and 6.30pm on the Saturday of the show. Cash prizes not collected within five days of the Show will be forfeited.
13. The pavilions will be closed to the public during judging; however, they will not be closed any later than 12 noon on each day of the Show.
14. Roy Keeping Highest Point Score Trophy. Where less than three entries in a class only First Place is counted towards point score.
15. DO NOT ENTER CLASSES MARKED \* FOR STEWARDS USE ONLY.
16. All care will be taken, but no responsibility will be accepted for exhibits.

## GENERAL REGULATIONS

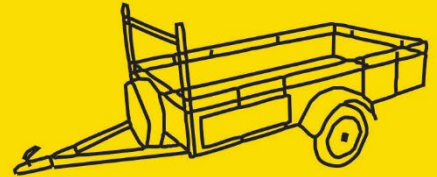
1. The Committee reserves the right to control the use of power amplifiers, etc., on the showground on Show days.

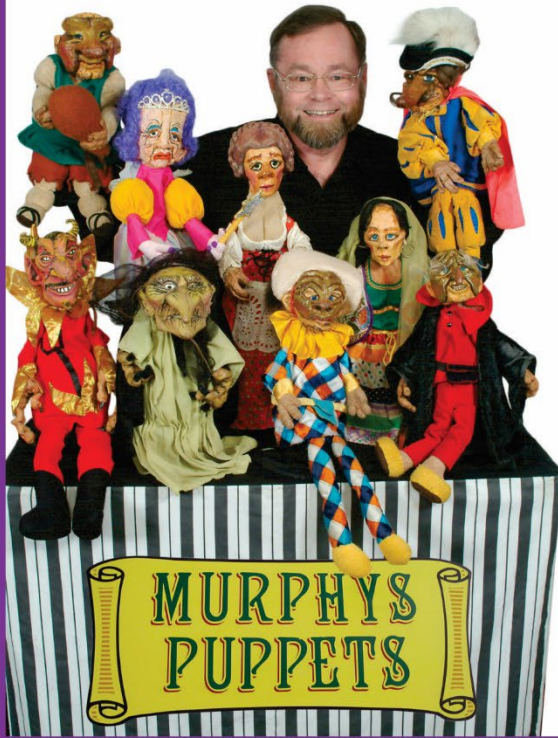

**REGULATIONS;** All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Shows Council of N.S.W. Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at [www.agshowsnsw.org.au](http://www.agshowsnsw.org.au). Should it become necessary for the A.S.C. Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by the Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from inquiries arising from Horse Section at other N.S.W. shows. Anyone who behaves offensively, or cruel to animals on the showground will be expelled from the showground and may be banned from the show in future. Coonabarabran P.A.I. & H. Association will not be responsible for any accidents that may occur through or by any exhibit and it shall be a condition of each entry that exhibitors shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accidents.

A **MAIDEN HACK** is a horse which has not won or been placed in any individual hack event at any official show.

A **NOVICE HACK** is a horse which has not placed 1st in a hack event at any official show.

**INTERMEDIATE HACK** is a horse which has never been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any individual hack event at any Royal Show.

**NEWCOMER** is a horse which has not competed under saddle [apart from racing] at any event before 01/01.2021 and must be ridden in a snaffle bit

**LOCAL:** Both horse and rider must reside in the Warrumbungle Shire for three months prior to the first day of the show. Rider does not need to own the horse. Full time students under the age of 25 years from local families attending remote education institutions are deemed to still be local

**HORSES MUST COMPETE AS A SHOW HUNTER OR HACK NOT BOTH**

**MINIATURE/SMALL & LITTLE HORSE** entries will be run under the Miniature Horse Federation Rules

**BREED CLASSES LED & RIDDEN:** All horses and owners MUST be registered & financial members of the classes respective Societies/ Associations & show paperwork if required.

**STALLIONS:** May only compete in designated stallion classes. Stallions must be wearing a bit at all times and under control of a person over 17 years and supervised at all times.

**LATENESS TO THE RING:** It is up to the Judge to accept any late arrivals to the ring

**HORSE MEASURING:** No official measuring will take place at the show, If there is a query about height, a current official height certificate will be required to be produced.

**HELMETS:** It is a rule of the Coonabarabran Showground that a current safety helmet must be worn at all times whilst riding horses. All under 17 years must wear a safety helmet whether riding or leading horses.

**PROTESTS:** a protest or complaint against any exhibit/exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the Ringmaster or Chief Steward no later than 10 minutes after the judging of the exhibit/exhibitor. The Ringmaster or Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the Protests Committee, which shall comprise the President, or Vice President, and two other members of the General Committee. All protest will incur a fee of \$50. **JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL, NO JUDGES ARE TO BE APPROACHED BY A COMPETITOR REGARDING THEIR DECISIONS.**

**ALL HORSES** are prohibited from entering the Main Enclosure for the duration of the show for safety reasons. This area is bounded by the ring to the east, the road to the west, the commercial area to the south and the sideshow area to the north.

The Committee reserves the right to alter the program at their disclosure and to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so.

### Rich Fruit Cake

#### Ingredients:

250g (8oz) sultanas	250g (8oz) chopped raisins
250g (8oz) currants	125g (4oz) chopped mixed peel
90g (3 oz) chopped red glace cherries	90g (3oz) chopped blanched almonds
1/3 cup sherry or brandy	250g (8oz) plain flour
60g (2oz) self-raising flour	1/4 teaspoon grated nutmeg
1/2 teaspoon ground ginger	1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
250g (8oz) butter	250g (8oz) soft brown sugar
1/2 teaspoon lemon essence or finely grated lemon rind	1/2 teaspoon almond essence
1/2 teaspoon vanilla essence	4 large eggs

#### Method:

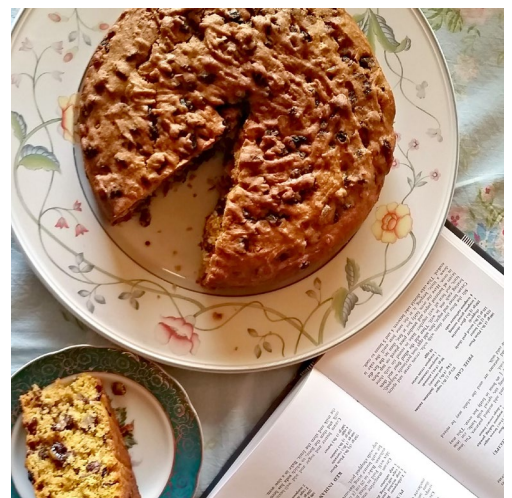
Mix together all the fruits and nuts and sprinkle with the sherry or brandy. Cover and leave for at least 1 hour, but preferably overnight. Sift together the flours and spices. Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition, then alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures, mix thoroughly. The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon. Place the mixture into a square, prepared tin no larger than 20cm x 20cm (8"x 8") tin and bake in a slow oven for approximately 3 ½ - 4 hours. Allow the cake to cool in the tin.

**Note:** to ensure uniformity and depending upon the size it is suggested the raisins be snipped into 2 or 3 pieces; cherries into 4-6 pieces and almonds cross-wise into 3-4 pieces.

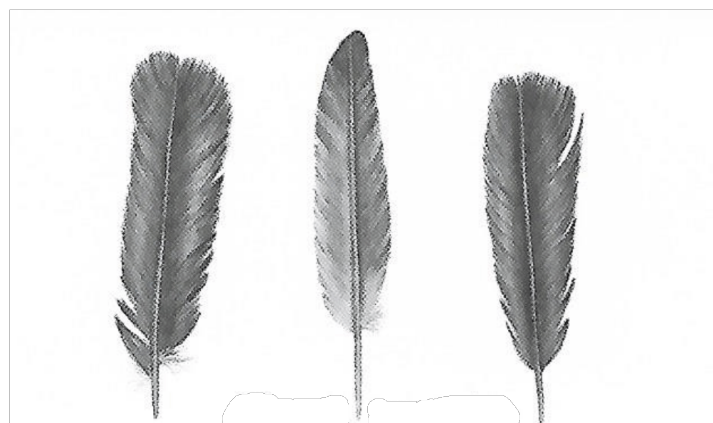

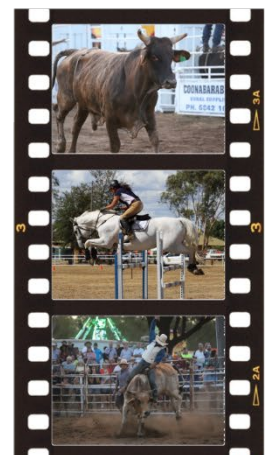

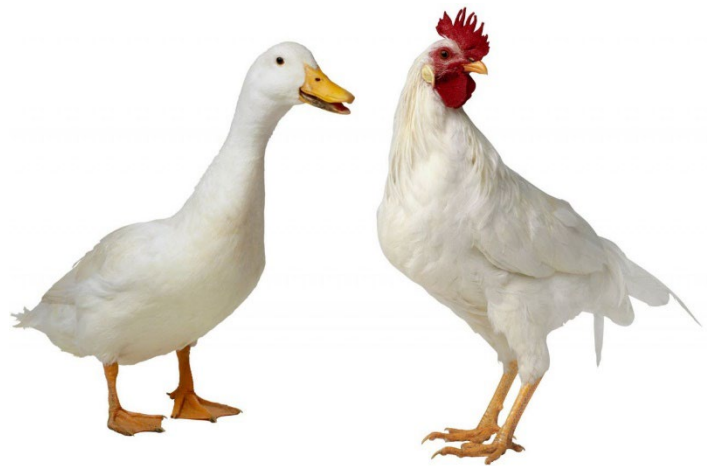
